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Notification to All Students and Scholars of NBU and Affiliated Colleges

In accordance with the instructions issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), it is **mandatory** for all students and scholars to obtain a **unique ABC/APPAR ID**.

❖ Important Instructions:

1. ABC/APPAR ID Generation

All students must generate their ABC ID **prior to filling up the Examination Form** for the upcoming session.

2. Aadhaar-Mobile Linkage Requirement

Students who have not yet linked their mobile number with Aadhaar are instructed to visit their **nearest Aadhaar Centre** and complete the linkage process. This step is **essential** for generating the ABC/APPAR ID.

3. Examination Form Submission

During the examination form fill-up, students must submit their:

- ABC/APPAR ID
- Aadhaar Name (Printed on Aadhaar Card)

4. Consequences of Non-Compliance

Candidates who fail to submit their ABC/APPAR ID within the stipulated timeframe will:

- Not receive hard copies of their marksheets
- Not have their e-Marksheets uploaded to the DigiLocker portal
- Not have their earned academic credits deposited in their ABC Account
